UAE SUPPORTS GOD'S PANTRY FOOD BANK WITH MUCH NEEDED MONETARY DONATION

Food Bank in Desperate Need of Community Support Following Severe Winter Weather

RAVENNA, KY., Feb. 4, 2009 – United American Energy (“UAE”) demonstrated its commitment to the community today with a \$2,000 donation to God’s Pantry Food Bank. The food bank recently announced that it has been depleted of many food staples and is attempting to meet an increased demand of emergency food assistance. Days after a severe winter storm overwhelmed most of the commonwealth, media outlets report that more than 200,000 citizens are still without electricity.

“Eastern Kentucky is our home,” said Bobby Short, vice president of field operations for UAE. “We are extremely concerned about the wellbeing of our fellow citizens and by the effect of this storm on our great community. We challenge other local businesses to be good corporate citizens and support God’s Pantry Food Bank and its current mission.”

“Many low-income households in Kentucky have been without power and will return to power with all the contents of their refrigerators spoiled,” said Marian F. Guinn, CEO of God’s Pantry Food Bank. “Our agencies are facing this problem on a large scale. Funds and food brought in during this state of emergency will help us to replenish the pantries of those most in need.”

UAE’s monetary donation will be used to replenish the shelves of food assistance agencies in Estill County. God’s Pantry Food Bank reports that for every \$1 donated, it can distribute \$10 worth of food. In 2008 the food bank and its member agencies distributed more than 13 million pounds of food to more than 159,000 individuals in 49 counties in central and eastern Kentucky.
