### **UNITED AMERICAN ENERGY ANNOUNCES NEW FIELD HEADQUARTERS IN RAVENNA**

Company Achieves Momentum on Well Rework and Infrastructure Improvement Program

**RAVENNA, KY., Sept. 11, 2008** – United American Energy (“UAE”) announced today the location of its new field headquarters in central Kentucky at 540 Pitts Rd. in Ravenna. UAE’s center of operations is now significantly closer to many of the company’s producing oil wells.

Formerly located in Clay City, Ky., UAE’s new 1,500-square feet field headquarters is expected to improve the company’s operating efficiency and support its growth strategy in Estill, Lee and Powell counties. The Estill County Chamber of Commerce will host a ribbon-cutting ceremony celebrating the new operations headquarters on Friday, Oct. 17, 2008, at 9 am. Open to the public, the ceremony is expected to include Irvine Mayor Earnest Lee Farmer and other dignitaries. Light refreshments will be served.

Through the course of 2007, UAE launched a well rework and infrastructure improvement program with the objective of stimulating oil production from legacy wells dating back to the early 1900s. To date more than 135 wells have been reworked throughout the company’s approximately 6,000 acres of oil fields contributing to the target of 6,000 barrels of oil production per month in 2008. Additional lease, well rework and infrastructure improvements are scheduled through the end of 2010.

“UAE is committed to improving and expanding its operations in the region,” said Bobby Short, vice president of field operations for UAE. “Our new field headquarters, well rework and infrastructure improvement program, newly enhanced employee safety program and environmental protection protocols demonstrate the company’s vision to become a leading oil producer in central Kentucky.”

A part of UAE’s enhanced safety procedures and environmental response plan, the company has installed an advanced communications system to allow instant communication between UAE employees in the field and the company’s field headquarters and emergency contacts.

“Due to the limited number of cell towers in the region, mobile phone communication was not a practical or dependable solution,” added Short. “This new technology will allow continuous and reliable communication between our employees and company headquarters during normal operations and when an urgent situation arises.”
